

## Yard Waste Collection

The Town of Harrisburg offers a weekly collection of leaves, grass and yard waste. The same streets can only be collected once per week. At peak times, such as during autumn leaf collection, pick-up schedules may vary due to increased workload. Collection crews are unable to return if you place your yard waste out after they have worked your street.

### Rules

- Leaves and grass must be loose (not bagged) and placed behind the curb (not in the road, but within 4 to 6 feet of the curb).
- Leaves and grass cannot be mixed with brush, dirt, paper, rocks, sticks or other debris.
- If other items are mixed with leaves and grass, the entire load will not be picked up.
- Yard waste must be at least 8 feet from any sign, water meter, landscaping, mailbox or other stationary object, and away from any low overhead lines.
- Yard waste consisting of brush must have limbs not to exceed 6 feet in length, stacked loosely with cut ends parallel to the street. Do not place yard waste in the curb. Yard waste needs to remain on your property until picked up.
- Yard waste consists of shrubs or tree limbs, flowers and plants only.
- If yard waste equals less than a truckload, there is no charge. A full truckload (16 feet long by 6 feet wide by 4 feet high) costs \$100.

## Harrisburg Park Renovation Update

Harrisburg Park is closed for renovation and expansion and is scheduled to re-open prior to the 2020 July 4th Celebration. Harrisburg Library and Harris Depot Park will remain open during construction.

## Transportation Bond

Transportation Bond was approved in November 2017 for \$4 million to be used for road, sidewalk and corridor improvements throughout Town. Major projects identified are: Road Resurfacing, Sidewalk Construction, Major Intersection Improvements and Hwy 49 Corridor Improvements. A significant number of Transportation Bond projects will be initiated in 2019-2020, but private development may speed up or slow down the implementation of some projects.

### Road Resurfacing

In coordination with the Town's annual paving contract, use of Transportation Bond funding will be spent this fall for road resurfacing. Resurfacing will take place over multiple years, with Transportation Bond funding expected to be used in future phases.

### Sidewalk Construction

Installation of new sidewalk along the following major corridors will begin this fall: Caldwell Road, Stallings Road, Harris Depot Road and Kee Lane.

### Major Intersection Improvements

- **Tom Query Road/Caldwell Road** - The Town will install a four-way stop at the intersection and the long-term plan is to install a signalized intersection with turn lanes.
- **Tom Query Road/Robinson Church Road** - A round-a-bout will be installed but the timeline is dependent upon potential residential development at the intersection.

- **Main Street/Roberta Road** - A signalized intersection will be installed and is expected to be fully funded and constructed as part of the Town Center rezoning approval.

- **Rocky River Road/Robinson Church Road** - Turn lanes will be installed on north and southbound Robinson Church Road.

### Hwy 49 Corridor Improvements

Hwy 49 Corridor improvements are at the bottom of the priority list while the Town determines if funding is available.

### Caldwell Road Extension (between Hwy 49 and Hwy 29/Concord Parkway):

A four-lane divided roadway corridor to connect Hwy 49 and Hwy 29/Concord Parkway will be designed as an economic development driver to what is mostly vacant, inaccessible land. This will create an alternate route to Morehead Road to reach Hwy 29/Concord Parkway and relieve traffic congestion on Morehead Road.
