

2021 Garbage & Recycling Collection Schedule

Please recycle these items:*

- ✓ Empty aerosol cans (no paint cans)
- ✓ All plastics 1-7 (no Styrofoam, bags or wrap)
- ✓ Wide-mouth plastic containers & lids
- ✓ Rigid plastic
- ✓ Containers & small hard plastic toys
- ✓ Milk and juice cartons & juice boxes
- ✓ Shredded paper in clear bag (no paint cans)
- ✓ Aluminum cans
- ✓ Metal food cans & lids
- ✓ Cereal & food boxes
- ✓ Cardboard boxes, flattened
- ✓ Mixed paper, newspapers with inserts & junk mail
- ✓ Paperback books
- ✓ Magazines & phonebooks
- ✓ Spiral paper cans, plastic lids detached

*Listed items are subject to collection in accordance with the MRF statutes and may change.

- Place carts for collection with wheels facing your home.
- Keep carts 2 feet from one another and 2 feet from parked cars, mailboxes, etc.
- Do not block sidewalks with carts.
- Rinse out all cans, bottles and jars.

Bulk items will be picked up on regularly scheduled collection day.

Harrisburg Community Transportation Plan



The Town Council adopted the Harrisburg Community Transportation Plan (CTP) during its October 12, 2020 meeting. A Public Hearing was held in September, and staff presented the final CTP draft and recommended Town Council adopt the plan.

Harrisburg's newly adopted CTP provides a vision for transportation recommendations that considers existing and future needs for all travel modes. The CTP will also serve as the local transportation plan to be included in the Cabarrus-Rowan Metropolitan Planning Organization's (MPO) Comprehensive Transportation Plan (CTP).

The creation of this Action Plan helps staff and elected officials advocate for projects that will have the greatest impact to the Town.

The Town has many identified transportation needs, and fully funding and implementing the recommendations will take a number of years. As projects move forward into funding and implementation, the Town will need to work with the Cabarrus-Rowan MPO and NCDOT to determine how best to advance recommended projects. The Town will also continue to monitor emerging needs and changes in the way projects can be funded and implemented. Project priorities will be reassessed through subsequent updates to this plan. This dynamic process will help the Town of Harrisburg continue to effectively address its transportation needs both now and into the future.

Yard Waste Collection

The Town of Harrisburg offers a weekly collection of leaves, grass and yard waste. The same streets can only be collected once per week. At peak times, such as during autumn leaf collection, pick-up schedules may vary due to increased workload. Collection crews are unable to return if you place your yard waste out after they have worked your street.

Rules

- Leaves and grass must be loose (not bagged) and placed behind the curb (not in the road, but within 4 to 6 feet of the curb).
- Leaves and grass cannot be mixed with brush, dirt, paper, rocks, sticks or other debris.
- If other items are mixed with leaves and grass, the entire load will not be picked up.
- Yard waste must be at least 8 feet from any sign, water meter, landscaping, mailbox or other stationary object, and away from any low overhead lines.
- Yard waste consisting of brush must have limbs not to exceed 6 feet in length, stacked loosely with cut ends parallel to the street. Do not place yard waste in the curb. Yard waste needs to remain on your property until picked up.
- Yard waste consists of shrubs or tree limbs, flowers and plants only.
- If yard waste equals less than a truckload, there is no charge. A full truckload (16 feet long by 6 feet wide by 4 feet high) costs \$100.

Local Park Playgrounds Reopen

The playgrounds at Stallings Park and Pharr Mill Park reopened September 4. Both playgrounds were pressure washed, inspected and sanitized prior to their reopening. All park visitors and playground users should follow the 3 Ws: Wear, Wait, Wash.

Solicitation Ordinance

Harrisburg's Solicitation Ordinance, approved by Council in November 2019, outlines prohibited acts, exceptions, permit requirements, begging, soliciting or panhandling and penalties within Town Limits.

Recognized charitable organizations, churches, schools, civic organizations and similar neighborhood associations performing fund raising, sales, marketing or other activities for their organization are exempt from the requirements of the Ordinance.

Introducing the CARTology App

Keeping track of weekly and every-other-week garbage and recycling services can be challenging. Not to mention, the Town also offers a variety of special events and season collection programs throughout the year to help residents manage waste as sustainably as possible. Fortunately, there are lots of collection reminder options available to help you remember trash, recycling, bulk item pick-up and extra trash service schedules.

All Harrisburg residents are encouraged to download the CARTology app and use the following collection reminder tools:

- **App Reminders:** Download the free CARTology app from the Apple Store or Google Play Store to view calendar information, access the Waste Wizard and Waste Sorting Game and set up customized push notifications.
- **Phone Call Reminders:** Select the time you would like to receive a reminder call the day before your collection day.
- **Calendar Downloads:** Download your service calendars to Google, iCal or Outlook, or save and/or print a PDF version of calendars.
- **Email Reminders:** Select the day and time you would like to receive your collection reminder.

COVID Update: Phase 3 Reopening


Under Executive Order 169, North Carolina entered into Phase 3 of lifting COVID-19 restrictions on Friday, October 2, 2020. As Harrisburg reopens its facilities to the public, the Town asks that all visitors practice the 3 Ws: Wear, Wait, Wash.

Depending on state COVID-19 trends, restrictions may be lifted more slowly or some restrictions may have to be reinstated to ensure the health and safety of North Carolinians.

It is important to note:

- If infections spike or benchmark trends begin to move in the wrong direction, the state may move to a previous phase to protect public health.
- The best science and data available will be used to make all decisions and continue consultation with business and industry leaders.
