

§ 71.03 PARKING NOT TO OBSTRUCT TRAFFIC.

No person shall park any vehicle upon a street, other than an alley, in such a manner or under such conditions as to leave available less than 22 feet of width of roadway for free movement of vehicular traffic.

§ 71.04 PARKING IN ALLEYS.

No person shall park a vehicle within an alley in such a manner or under such conditions as to leave available less than ten feet of the width of the roadway for the free movement of vehicular traffic, and no person shall stop, stand, or park a vehicle within an alley, in such position as to block the driveway entrance to any abutting property.

§ 71.05 STANDING OR PARKING FOR CERTAIN PURPOSES PROHIBITED.

It shall be unlawful for any person to stand or park a vehicle upon any street of the town for the principal purpose of:

(A) Displaying for sale;

(B) Washing, greasing or repairing such vehicle, except repairs made necessary by a bonafide emergency;

(C) Storing by garages, dealers or other persons when such storing is not incident to the bona fide use and operation of such automobile or other vehicle; or

(D) Storing of any detached trailer or van when the towing unit has been disconnected or for the purpose of transferring merchandise or freight from one vehicle to another.

§ 71.06 PARKING ADJACENT TO SCHOOLS.

When official signs are erected indicating no parking upon either side of a street adjacent to any school property as authorized herein, no person shall park a vehicle in any such designated place.

§ 71.07 MANNER OF PARKING.

No person shall stand or park a vehicle in a roadway other than parallel with the edge of the roadway headed in the direction of lawful traffic movement and with the right-hand wheels of the vehicle within 18 inches of the curb or edge of the roadway except as otherwise provided in this chapter.

§ 71.08 ALL NIGHT PARKING.

No person shall park a vehicle on any street between the hours of 1:00 a.m. and 6:00 a.m. of any day.

§ 71.09 PARKING IN HANDICAPPED PARKING SPACE.

It shall be unlawful for any person to without privilege park or leave standing a vehicle in a space designated for handicapped and visually impaired persons in accordance with G.S. § 20-37.6 (e) (1).

§ 71.10 STANDING IN CURB LOADING ZONES.

(A) No person shall stop, stand or park a vehicle for any purpose or length of time other than for the expeditious unloading and delivery or pickup and loading of materials in any place marked as a curb loading zone during hours when the provisions applicable to such zones are in effect. In no case shall the stop for loading and unloading of materials exceed 15 minutes.

(B) The driver of a passenger vehicle may stop temporarily at a place marked as a curb loading zone for the purpose of and while actually engaged in loading and unloading passengers when such stopping does not interfere with any motor vehicle used for the transportation of materials that is waiting to enter or about to enter such zone.
