I. Consent Agenda:

a. Old Business:

- a. Matching incentive grant.
 - i. Deadline is October 14, 2016 and June of 2017 are two dates for submittal.
 - ii. 50% Matching Grant with county for field repairs
 1. Protective Netting at Harrisburg Elementary
 - a. One quote was \$18,000
 - b. Looking at netting for between fields 5 & 6 for public safety
 - c. Also, Harrisburg Elementary Dugouts or shade would be useful
 2. Town Council spoke about doing a matching grant.
