OLD BUSINESS

- Update on 501c3
 - The Town is now the manager/administrator of the HYA 501(c)3
 - Officers are Eric Smallwood, President, Shawn Marble, Secretary, and Lee Connor as treasurer.
 - They are in the process of setting up bank accounts
 - The existing name will remain
- Update on the Greenway
 - WASACC has written agreements for landowners, both commercial and individual, regarding the crossing of pedestrians.
 - A preliminary plan is needed before crafting the agreement.

NEW BUSINESS

- Farmers Market
 - Two ADA compliant bridges may be built by the developer that has purchased the adjacent property in trade for use of park property for the necessary cul-de-sac and drainage ponds.
- Manager Update
 - Capital improvements continue with the expected construction of seating on selected intersection corners of Hwy. 49.
 - Banners will be up soon that say “Live, Work, Play” along the highway.
- Events Update
 - July 4th
 - The fourth was a success, perhaps with the largest crowd ever.
 - Market on Main is planned for 9/28
- Program Update
 - Zoomba starts on 9/11 and will be held on Wednesdays and Saturdays.
- Athletics Update
