



Carbon Monoxide Safety

Carbon Monoxide (CO) is a dangerous, odorless, and poisonous gas. Heating and cooking devices that burn fuel can be sources of CO.



Where do I place a CO alarm?

- Outside each sleeping area and on every level of the home.
- At least 15-feet away from fuel burning appliances.

How do I prevent a CO leak in my home?

- Only use a charcoal grill, hibachi, lantern, or portable camping stove outdoors.
- Never use the oven to heat your home.
- Ensure chimneys and flues are checked annually and are without blockages.
- Always run your car, generator, and any gas-powered motors outdoors and not in your home or garage.
