SPRING 2021 ADULT COED SOFTBALL COVID SAFETY REQUIREMENTS

While we continue to monitor and follow COVID guidelines here are some examples of what can be expected:

- Social distancing efforts will be maximized for the safety of all players, spectators, coaches, officials and staff.
- Masks will not be required for our athletes as long as they are practicing social distancing during games. Participants are welcome to wear masks if they prefer.
- Face masks are **required** when entering/exiting the facility and when in the dugout during game play.
- We **require** each participant bring a mask to use during times that social distancing is not possible.
- Officials and staff are **required** to wear a face mask. "Mask breaks" are encouraged at the appropriate times and should happen while practicing the proper social distancing.
- Spectators are asked to bring their own chairs and to social distance a minimum of 6' from other families. Spectators should wear face coverings if 6' social distance can not occur from non-family members.
- Participants are asked to wash their hands thoroughly prior to attending games and after leaving.
- Game times may be staggered to reduce the amount of people in the park at one time.
- Spectator attendance, spectator capacity, spectator social distancing and mask wearing will be evaluated and addressed as we get closer to the program offering based on the NC Governor's orders and CDC recommendations.
- Program cancellation or postponement are also possibilities if it is deemed in the best interest of public safety.
- If you/teammate or any member of your/teammates household is experiencing any Covid related symptoms such as, but not limited to: fever, chills, cough, loss of taste or smell and/or shortness of breath, please do not attend games. If you/teammate or any member of your/teammates household has been placed on quarantine, please do not attend games.
- Sanitizing Stations will be available at each field to include hand sanitizer, disinfectant spray and disinfectant wipes.
