HARRISBURG, N.C., April 21, 2021 – Haynes Brigman announced his resignation from the position of Town Manager, effective June 1, 2021 after serving four years in the role.

During Mr. Brigman's tenure with the Town, Harrisburg has accomplished many amazing things and completed several large projects, including new parks, fire stations, facilities and infrastructure. The Town has upgraded its equipment, advanced technical and service capabilities, persevered through a global pandemic and has grown tremendously as a professional organization. He has been integral in bringing a new train station to Harrisburg in the near future and overseeing the updates to many Town plans, such as the Harrisburg Area Land Use Plan, Unified Development Ordinance, Highway 49 Corridor Plan and Transportation Plan, among others. Mr. Brigman has also helped improve employee benefits, increase pay opportunities for staff and generated more opportunities for employee fellowship and wellness.
